Safer & Less Painful

The DermaSculpt Microcannula® does not cut through vessels and tissues but rather navigates smoothly through the dermis and Sub-Q layer. As a result, it's much safer than using a classic sharp needle. The blunt end and flexibility of the microcannula allow for an almost painless and non-traumatic procedure.

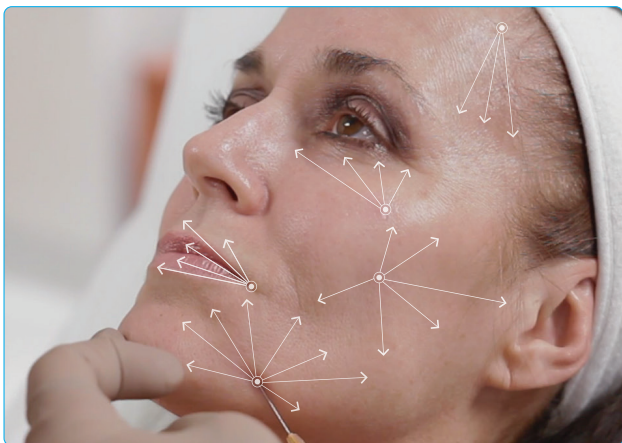
Generates Collagen

The “back and forth” mechanical action of the DermaSculpt Microcannula® on the “fibroblasts” naturally forces the skin to create new collagen.

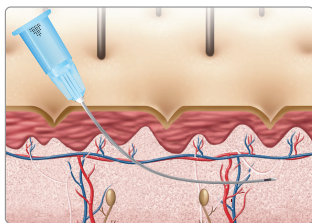
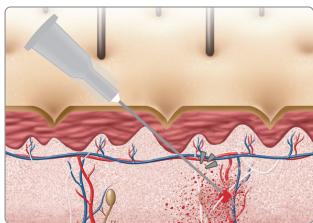
More Coverage

Through the fanning technique, and due to the length of the microcannula, very few entry points are needed in order to treat the entire face.

COMPARED TO USING A SHARP NEEDLE

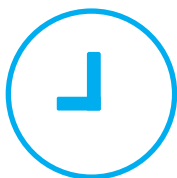


Classic Needle with sharp tip

Cuts through blood vessels and nerves causing bruising and pain.

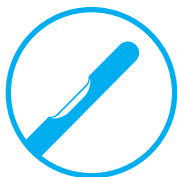
DermaSculpt with blunt tip

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION

What is the procedure best used for?

DermaSculpt Microcannulas are available in several sizes and gauges, meaning they can be used with all dermal fillers currently available on the market.

Am I a good candidate?

If you're a candidate for filler injections then you're a candidate for a painless injection with DermaSculpt Microcannula®. Restrictions may apply for patients who've had permanent fillers in the late 1990's, be sure to consult with your physician.

Are there any side effects I should be aware of?

Redness and mild swelling are the most common side effects associated with the procedure. But nothing to worry about, both are modest and should not have any effect on social life.
